The Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt presents its compliments to the esteemed Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Norway, and has the honour to highlight the process for applying for visas to all participants at the 27<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP27), which will be held in Sharm El-Sheikh from 6<sup>th</sup> till the 18<sup>th</sup> of November 2022.

Kindly note that all participants can obtain a free visa to Egypt provided they fulfill the below steps:

- 1- Register online at the Conference through the UNFCCC site and submit the generated "Acknowledgment Letter" (as a proof of registration).

- 2- The Visa Application Form (attached in pdf format), provide 2 photos and Note Verbale (where applicable).
- 3-Also apply for visa online which is an additional requirement to those participating at the conference: <https://cop27.eg/#!/trip-planning/visa/apply>.
- 4-For media participants, they need to apply through the UNFCCC site:
