Participants

The participants will consist of teams of 3 persons. The invitation will be sent both nationally and internationally to institutions within design, architecture and fine art. In addition to the competition, the programme also emphasizes social events and network building. We also want you to get to know Bergen and its surroundings!

Economy

BIWF covers food and hotel expenses for participants, and also local transportation in Bergen. The participants must cover travel expenses to/from Bergen.

Working process

The competition will take place in the centre of Bergen, along the east side of the lake Store Lungegårdsvann.

The teams will have an area based on their needs. The height is unlimited, but stability must be documented. The teams work within a limited time- period, and materials will be delivered to the construction site.

The teams must prepare their project in form of a concept, a model, sketches etc.

Materials

There are unlimited access to wood materials:

- dimension 48x48 mm
- dimension 21x48 mm

Special details, like bolts and levers etc, must be provided by the team. Standard connectors like nails and screws will be available.

Tools

The teams must bring their own tools. Electricity will be provided to each unit.

Exhibition

The completed constructions are the property to Bergen Municipal. The works will remain on the site one month. During Bergen International Music Festival, a week after the competition, the structures will be illuminated at night.

Throughout the competition, there will be documentation of the process and the projects. This documentation will be made available to the participants after the project period is over.
