With reference to the Agreed Record of Conclusion of Fisheries Consultations on the Management of the Norwegian Spring-Spawning (Atlanto-Scandian) herring stock in the North-East Atlantic for 2008 between the Russian Federation, the European Community, the Faroe Islands, Iceland and Norway of 12 November 2007, separate bilateral arrangements on access to the respective zones of fisheries jurisdiction of the Parties have been concluded.

The following arrangement between Norway and the Russian Federation will be applied:

Within the framework of the above five party arrangement the Russian Federation is granted access to fish 194,607 tonnes of herring in areas under Norwegian fisheries jurisdiction north of 62°N.
